Itinerary

Monday 16 September – Tuesday 24 September 2024 (9 Days / 8 Nights)

Day 1 / Monday to Skopje:

Late afternoon meet and greet at 4* hotel Best Western Tourist in Skopje, for 3 nights. Dinner at hotel (D)

Day 2 / Tuesday - Skopje:

Walking tour of Old & New Skopje, covering Gate Macedonia, the Main Square with grand fountain of Alexander the Great, Mother Theresa Memorial House, Old Railway Station, House of Parliament, Stone Bridge, the Old Bazaar with the Ottoman Hammams and Inns, St Holly Salvation church and the Fortress Kale. Lunch. (B, L, D)

Day 3 / Wednesday - Staro Nagorichane and Lesnovo:

Full day excursion to visit the church of St George in the village of Staro Nagorichane, then continue to the towers and bridges of Kratovo. Lunch. Then continue to Lesnovo Monastery. (B, L, D)

Day 4 / Thursday - Stobi and Bitola:

Drive towards Bitola with stop to visit archaeological site, Ancient city of Stobi. Continue to Demir Kapija for a wine tasting and lunch at winery. Continue to Bitola and visit Heraclea Lyncestis, the most vividly preserved city from the ancient Macedonian empire, and further continue to Ohrid. Dinner and overnight at 4* hotel for 3 nights. (B, L, D)

Day 5 / Friday - Ohrid:

Walking tour of Ohrid including visits to the church of Sveti Bogorodica Perivpleta, the Icon Museum, Samoil's Fortress, the amphitheatre, the churches of St Clement - Plaosnik, St Jovan – Kaneo and St Sofia. Lunch. Free afternoon. Dinner at hotel. (B,L,D)

Day 6 / Saturday - Ohrid Lake and St Naum:

Leave towards the south of Ohrid lake to visit Ancient settlement on water – Bay of Bones, then continue to St Naum Monastery at the very south of Ohrid Lake, near Albanian border. Visit the church and lunch at a restaurant at St Naum complex and small boats tour to see the sources that feed the Ohrid Lake. Back to Ohrid in the afternoon. Free time. Dinner at restaurant – Traditional Macedonian Evening with folk dance show. (B, L, D)

Day 7 / Sunday - Mavrovo & Skopje:

Divine Liturgy in the morning. Drive towards Skopje to the National Park Mavrovo, visiting St. George, women's monastery and then the monastery of St Jovan Bigorski. Lunch in a restaurant. Continue to Skopje. Dinner and overnight at 4* hotel Best Western Tourist in Skopje for 2 nights. (B, L, D)

Day 8 / Monday - Gorno Nerezi and Skopje:

Visit of Canyon Matka and St Andrew church, boat tour to Vrelo cave in the canyon, then continue to visit St Pantelejmon at Gorno Nerezi. Lunch and then further continue to Marko's Monastery. Return to Skopje. Free afternoon. Dinner at hotel. (B, L, D)
